

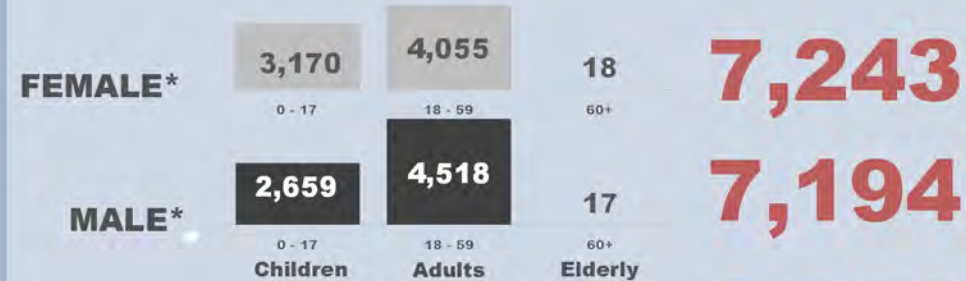

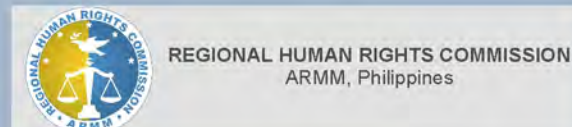

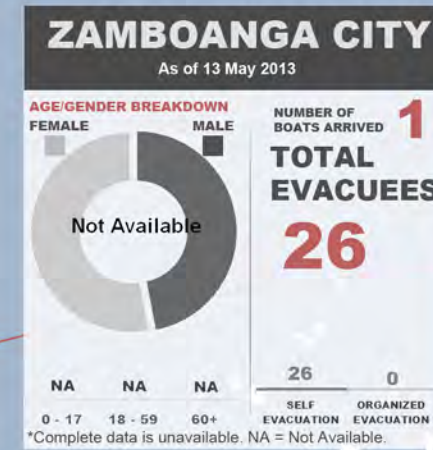
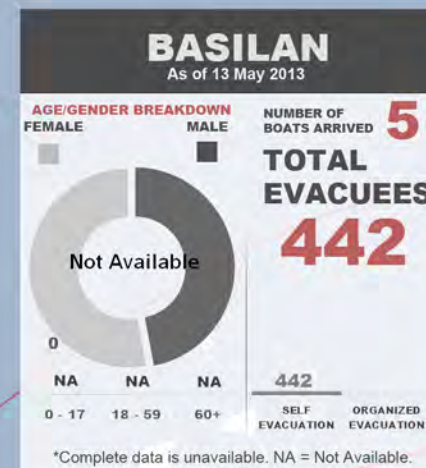

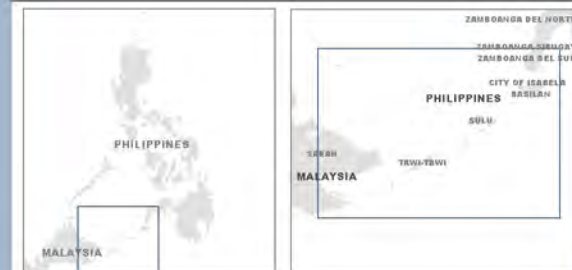
UNKNOWN AGE AND GENDER BREAKDOWN **2,263**
